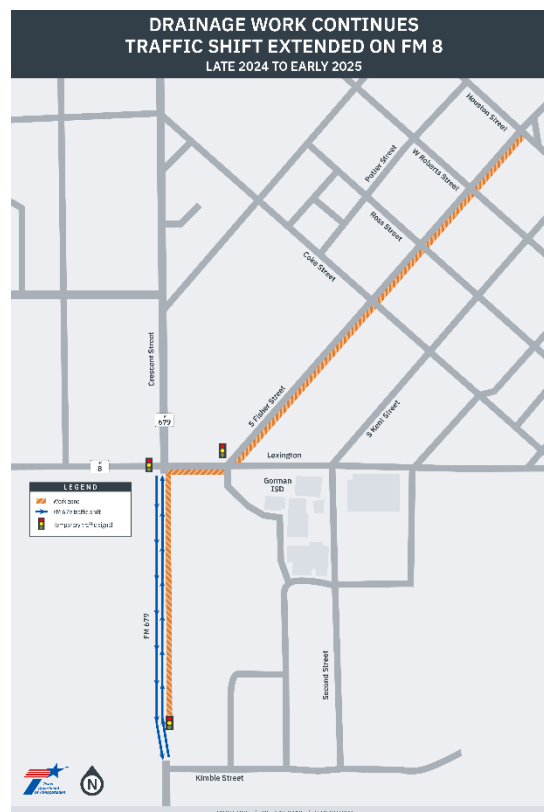


Drainage work continues, traffic shift to be extended on FM 8

November 7, 2024

GORMAN – Beginning Monday, November 11, 2024, weather permitting, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will extend the work zone and shift traffic to the west on FM 8 (Fisher Street) from the intersection of S Fisher Street and Lexington to Houston Street. The traffic shift is scheduled to remain in place through early 2025.

The current configuration of the work zone will remain the same as in the previous phases of construction. However, the traffic shift will be extended on FM 8. The closure on Lexington, between Kent Street to S Fisher Street, will reopen to through traffic once the extended traffic shift is implemented.



Please follow all directional signage and watch for crews and equipment in the work zone. Traffic delays could occur, please plan accordingly.

Work to upgrade drainage structures through this area is ongoing and is expected to be complete in spring 2025. Various lane closures will occur throughout the duration of construction. Project updates and possible traffic impacts will be shared as work is scheduled.
